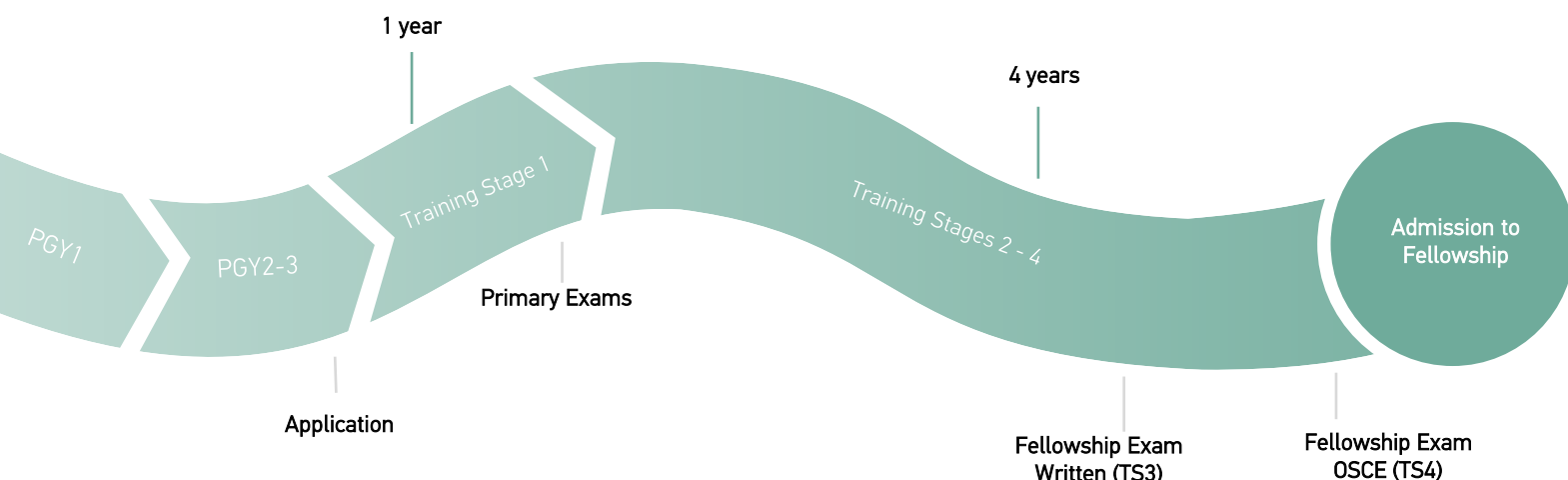

General Medical Registration With AHPRA or MCNZ	Minimum PGY3+ at any time of application	One 6-month FTE placement in a single Emergency Department entirely within the date range specified for the round in which applied for – refer to ACEM website for dates  3 placements (min 2 months FTE each) in 3 different disciplines other than emergency medicine  At least 1 non-ED placement completed during or after PGY2	2 application rounds per year (can apply once per year)
