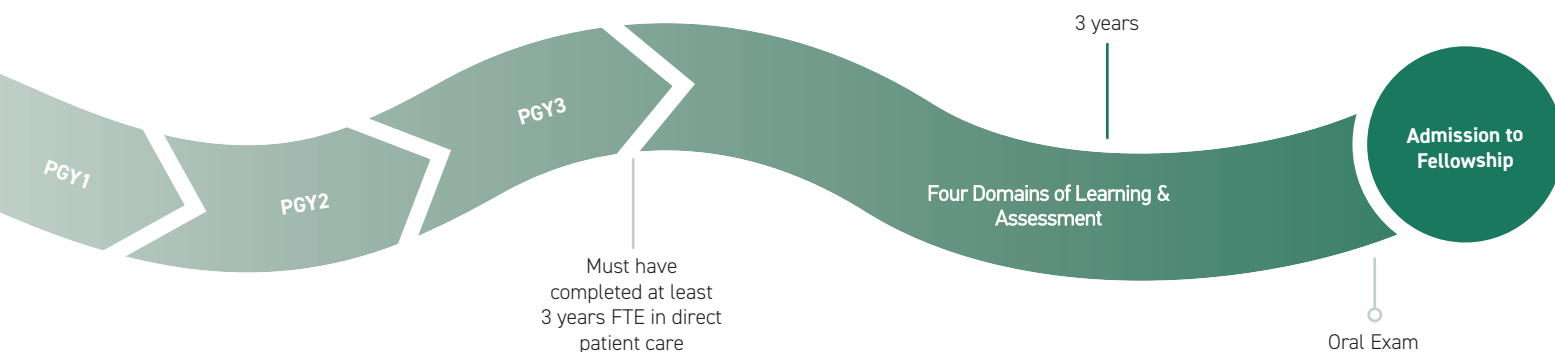

Annual Training Plans Research Training Requirements	For Candidates commencing in 2024, HHS requires the completion of 5 core Masters Subjects detailed on the RAMCA website.
